

Lebanon Public Library

- Located in Lebanon, IN
- 30,000 s.f. addition, 18,000 s.f. renovation
- Project Description: To meet the demand of community growth, Lebanon Public Library underwent a addition/renovation to the existing Carnegie library. The project involved a reorganization of the interior and an expansion of all services. The goals of the design were to increase the size while maintaining the architectural style and historic character of the split level building. A vending area appropriately called the "Sugar Bowl" was designed and styled after a local favorite '50s style ice cream parlor, which was once located on the same downtown historic courthouse square.
